Standard of care

The distance between 'impossible' and 'routine' is usually just two things: evidence, and time. Here are nine ideas that made the jump.

▸ PROVEN

A bacterium causes them — and antibiotics cure them.

To prove it when no one believed him, Dr. Barry Marshall drank a flask of *H. pylori*, gave himself gastritis, then cured it. A lifetime of antacids became a 10-day prescription.

Nobel Prize, 2005 · ulcers reclassified as an infection

CRISPR now edits the faulty code out of a patient’s own cells.

Casgevy — the first FDA-approved CRISPR therapy — frees people with sickle cell disease from the agonizing pain crises that once defined their lives.

~16,000 people eligible · a one-time treatment

They built one for a single baby — in about six months.

Born with a fatal metabolic disorder,
“Baby KJ” received a CRISPR base-editing
therapy designed for his exact mutation,
delivered into his liver. He’s growing and
thriving.

Diagnosis → bespoke therapy in ~6 months

Gene-edited pig kidneys are keeping patients alive.

After decades of failure, recipients have lived months on pig kidneys. In 2025 the first FDA-regulated xenotransplant trial began — a real path toward ending the organ shortage.

271 days – longest pig-kidney survival to date

People now move cursors — and speak — by thought alone.

With an implanted brain-computer interface, paralyzed users browse, game, hold jobs, and (for those who’ve lost their voice to ALS) communicate again in real time.

12+ implant recipients · 15,000+ hours of daily use

Personalized mRNA vaccines are teaching the body to.

Custom-built from each patient’s tumor,
an mRNA vaccine paired with
immunotherapy sharply cut melanoma’s
return. Phase 3 trials are now running
across many cancers.

44% lower recurrence risk in melanoma (Phase 2b)

**AI now does it in minutes —
for nearly every known
protein.**

AlphaFold cracked a 50-year grand challenge of biology and mapped the structures of essentially all catalogued proteins, accelerating drug discovery in labs worldwide.

~200,000,000 structures · used in 190 countries

What's crossing over next.

Editing on demand — bespoke gene therapies for ultra-rare diseases, built patient by patient.

Pig organs in trials — regulated studies aiming to end the transplant waiting list.

Cancer vaccines — moving from trials toward standard of care.

Brain interfaces at scale — from a handful of patients to the clinic.

AI-designed proteins — medicines that never existed in nature.

A healthy caveat: not every bold claim survives the evidence — and that's the point. "De-extinct" dire wolves are really edited gray wolves; pig organs still fail; amyloid drugs help only modestly. Skepticism is how the real ones earn their place.

The next “impossible” is already in a lab somewhere.

The pattern holds: **dismissed** → **resisted** → **routine**.
